



APHIA is providing 2 bursaries to support students/scientists to attend the 2019 International Summer School in Canada.

You must apply to the summer school first and have application approval before applying for the APHIA bursary.

You must be a current financial APHIA membership (financial at the start of November 2018) to apply for the bursary.

Applicants for bursaries must supply:

- Application Approval from the Summer School (available 1st of April)
- Letter of application including statement of motivation for attending and a summary of current research or case study presentation.
- CV
- Letter of support from supervisor/head of department
- Completed application form (see below)

The closing date for bursary applications is 05/04/19. You will be informed if your application is successful or not by the 12/04/19. **This application is for the bursary only.**

Bursary application criteria are listed below:

- Stay for the whole duration of the summer school and attend all sessions.
